weather and mud would help a great deal in keeping our building looking neat and less calls to home for wet clothes! Students still need boots and jackets for recesses. We appreciate your support in this!

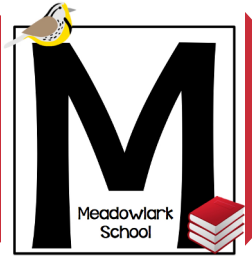
